Codicil form to amend your Will

If you have already made a Will, and now wish to add SPANA as one of your beneficiaries, you can ask a solicitor to help you complete this Codicil form. A Codicil is a supplement that changes or adds to an existing Will and is a legal document, so we recommend that you consult a solicitor to ensure that it is signed and witnessed correctly to ensure it is valid. Please keep your Codicil with, but not stapled to, your Will and in a safe place.
