Summary of role

SPANNA is seeking a passionate and committed individual to support the organisation in mapping the global needs of working animals. This opportunity will offer strong research and vocational experience working alongside the organisations Service Delivery Team.

Our Global Needs Framework aims to map the areas of highest animal welfare needs across the globe so that SPANNA can strategically plan where to focus our charitable resources and make the greatest difference to the lives of working animals.

This internship will take place during a particularly exciting time for SPANNA as we update our global strategy. Working in collaboration with the Service Delivery Team, the position will be tasked with searching for and entering secondary data into our framework. A key part of this role involves data entry. The position will also offer the opportunity to learn more about how this type of research can guide our charity's work and future progress.

Main Accountabilities

- Carry out desk research, data entry tasks and basic excel analysis.
- Liaise with the Services Team to provide feedback on the framework and its processes.
- Assist with data visualization using Microsoft Power BI
- Present final framework results and recommendations
