

## Veterinary Wish List

- Stethoscopes – good quality e.g. Littmann
- Thermometers
- Farriery equipment:
 

Hoof rasps	Hoof testers
Hoof knives	Hoof clippers
Nail pullers	Farriers chaps (clothing)
- Dentistry equipment:
 

Gags	Large dental syringes
Dental rasps – manual or electric	Replacement burrs for the rasps
Dental picks	Dental mirrors
Head torches	Head stands
- Ophthalmoscopes
- Suture material (all kinds, unopened). Expired suture material is also useful for veterinary student training
- Surgical gloves and gowns
- Surgical equipment – forceps, scissors, scalpel handles etc
- Ultrasound machines – Good quality second hand machines also considered
- Endoscopes – Good quality second hand scopes will also be considered
- Tack: Head collars/lead ropes/saddle pads/girths/bits
- Medicines will be considered on a case-by-case basis, but they must be unopened, have been stored correctly and have at least 6 months left before the expiry date. Acceptance of medication will be subject to appropriateness for our needs, ease of storage or shipping and import permits.
